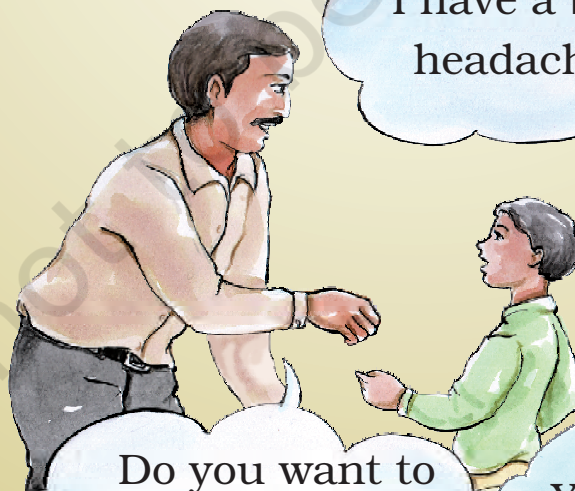

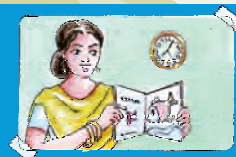

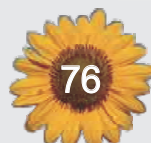
1. BUTTERFLIES

Down, down, down.

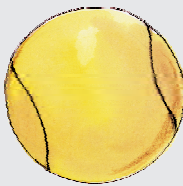
Butterflies, butterflies,

Out, out, out.



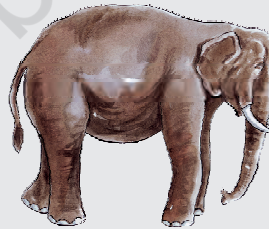
2. Write the colour of the object in the space given.
