

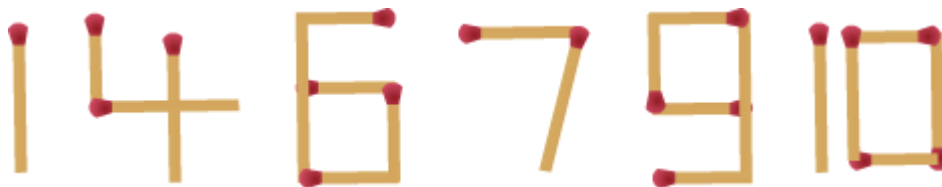
Lines And Lines

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Question 1: • Collect used matchsticks. Have fun making numbers and letters with these. • Is there any number or letter that you cannot make with matchsticks? • Now write some numbers using straight lines. • What about writing letters using straight lines? Which ones are easy? • Find out where else numbers and letters are written with straight lines.

Answer:

- No, all numbers or letters can be made with matchsticks.
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- All the letters of the English alphabet can be easily written using straight lines. Letters like A, C, D, E, F, H, I, K, L, M, N, P, R, S, T, U, V, W, X and Z can be written using straight lines.
