- iii) What were the articles of accusation against Gulliver for treason and other crimes?
- iv) Describe the return journey of Gulliver to his native land.
- v) Describe some funny situations based upon your reading of part 1.

B:- QUESTIONS BASED ON PART 2

- i) Pen down the encounter between Gulliver and the giant reaper.
- ii) In the island of Lilliput, Gulliver was at the top because of his huge size but in Brobdingang ha had to undergo numberless sufferings because of his short stature. Explain.
- iii) What greatest danger did Gulliver face in the country Brobdingang ? Describe the monkey episode.
- iv) King’s discussion with Gulliver reflect a bold picture of the so-called civilized world. Explain.
- v) How did Gulliver behave when he came back to England?

You should be creative and original in preparing the book cover. All answers should be original . Use your thinking and understanding abilities to express yourself clearly and coherently.You can add pictures to make it impressive. Looking forward for the colourful presentations.Put suitable

headings on each sheet . (wherever required) . Use A4 Size coloured sheets to write your answers. Put all your answers in self made folder.

Ques 4:- A poem always begins in delight and ends in wisdom. It helps us to understand the wonders of nature so let us turn to a famous poems this summer. You can choose poem written by any of the following poets:

Poem Recitation activity will be conducted after the holidays. Write the poem on a A3 sized white cartridge sheet. Don't forget to put border to it and draw related picture based on the theme of the poem and make it more impressive and presentable. Make audio recording of your poem in a CD with proper into nations. The recordings must be of 3-4 minutes.

Ques 5:- Movies are one of the important source of entertainment for our teenagers . Watch some English movies and write the review of any one English movie that you have seen and enjoyed on A4 size coloured sheets. Your work should be neat and clean. You can add pictures, photographs or drawings to make it more impressive. Each review should carry the following details about the film

Quote one of your favourite dialogues from the movie. Also prepare a your own script based on the text for role play activity after the vacations. Prepare hardcopy of the same and put in a self made folder. Also record some of your favourite dialogues with proper expressions and voice modulation in the same CD as used in Ques 4.

Ques 6:- Prepare a Pamphlet on an A4 size sheet from any one of the following topics:
