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Question 1: Order, rub, puzzle, erase, court

Answer: 1) **Order:** a command Example sentences: 1) My class teacher ordered me to leave the classroom. 2) I ordered the waiter to get a pizza for me.

2) **Rub:** to move to and fro against each other Example sentences: 1) I rubbed my hand against the wall. 2) Write the answers with pencil so that you can rub it with an eraser.

3) **Puzzle:** confused Example sentences: 1) I was puzzled by the magician's magic. 2) This poem has always been a puzzle for me.

4) **Erase:** to rub or remove Example sentences: 1) My brother erased all the answers I wrote. 2) Its difficult to erase precious memories.

5) **Court:** a body of people with a judge to solve civil and criminal cases Example sentences: 1) The court will be closed on this Monday. 2) It is not easy to deal with court cases.

1. What did Akbar order one day?
2. What did each minister do?
3. How did Birbal make the line shorter?

Answer:

1. Akbar drew a line on the floor and ordered to make it shorter without rubbing any part of it.
2. Each minister looked at the line and was puzzled.
3. Birbal drew a longer line under the first one.
