Question 12: Why are the following things important in a house?

They are important for fresh air and sunlight.

This is the most important use of a good drainage system; it allows the free flow of water and in most cases prevents accumulation that can lead to flooding. Drainage

systems also prevent the accumulation of stagnant water, which can encourage mosquitoes to breed.

(c) Open spaces

Open spaces improve the general health and well-being of the residents. It reduces stress, encourages physical activity.

Question 13: What will you do before crossing a busy road?

Answer: Use a crosswalk as a pedestrian if one is available. Look left and right and then left and check if any vehicle is moving towards you. If the road is clear you can cross it, but if the road is not clear wait for the road to clear.

Question 14: What will you do if someone is injured in an accident?

Answer: When an accident happens and someone gets hurt, we should try to keep cool and help the injured person. The first immediate help that an injured person needs is called first aid.

Explanation: In case of bleeding, wash the wound with clean water and cotton.
