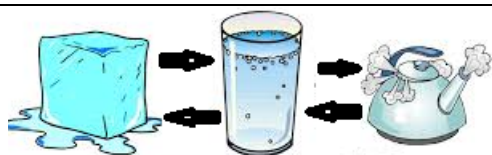
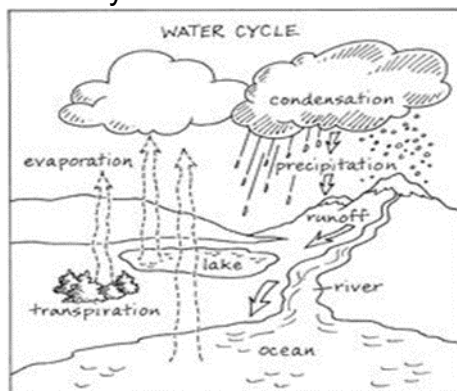


CLASS 6 ICSE CHEMISTRY WATER

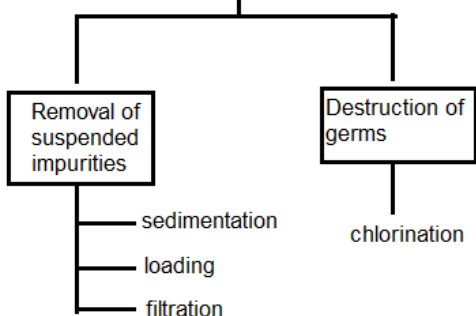


Water exists in three states solid ice, liquid water and gaseous vapour
 Sources of water on earth include
 Surface water: oceans, rivers, seas, lakes, ponds
 Underground water: wells, springs
 Above surface: rainwater
 Water is a universal solvent and can dissolve many substances

The continuous circulation of water from earth to atmosphere and back is called water cycle



PURIFICATION OF DRINKING WATER



Potable water: Water suitable for drinking. Should be clean, transparent, odourless, free of impurities, germs and should contain some dissolved minerals and gases to give it taste



Prevented by:
 Proper collection and disposal of sewage
 Proper treatment of industrial wastes to reduce effluents
 Treatment of effluents before releasing into water
