Practical Exercise 11

Objective:

1. To enable students to understand the **impact of Industrial Revolution** during the British Raj in India.

Material Required:

- 1. Unlined/blank sketchbook (A3).
- 2. Scissor, glue.
- 3. Reference books, magazines.

Procedure:

- Identify specific categories of textiles and clothing worn in England and Europe which were based on Indian exports during the Industrial Revolution.
- 2. Visit a museum for additional information (optional).
- 3. Refer to books, journals in the library and the internet to do the following:
 - i. Find articles on the impact of restrictive rules and regulations on Indian weavers during the British Raj.
 - ii. Find pictures of European garments using Indian textiles and prints.
- 4. Use photocopies of visuals and paste them on sheets/notebook with suitable labels indicating the product (textiles and clothing), reference name (if any) and year.
- 5. Submit these to the teacher. In addition make a presentation to the class.
