Practical Exercise 15

Objectives:

- 1. To use selected **movies** as a source of historical reference for costume.
- 2. To identify movies as one of the sources of fashion trends.

Material Required:

- 1. Unlined/blank sketchbook (A3).
- 2. Scissor, glue.
- 3. Fashion magazines.

Procedure:

The teacher will do the following:

- i. Discuss a few movies based on the following criteria:
 - Movies in which the costumes have started fashion trends in India.
 - * Movies in which the costumes have been designed after authentic research.
 - * Movies which have won national / international awards for Best Costume.
- 2. Discuss the costumes through a PPT of selected stills from the movie.
- 3. Discuss whether the costume designers of these movies are fashion designers too.

The students will do the following:

- 1. Identify a movie based on one of the above criteria which he/she has viewed earlier.
- 2. Review the movie again and analyze the details of the costumes and accessories.
- 3. Find visuals from old/ current magazines or internet which show the popularity and spread of these designs across society.
- 4. Compile the visuals in a notebook in a way to show how the original costume has inspired the commercial designs.

Observation and Discussion:

- 1. Does commercial success of movies affect the popularity of costumes?
- 2. Does the star status of the actors affect the popularity of costumes?
- 3. Does fashion inspired from movie costumes spread across society?
