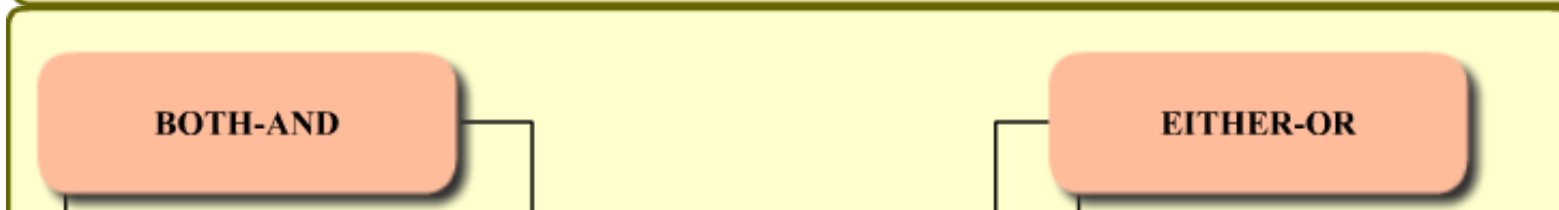
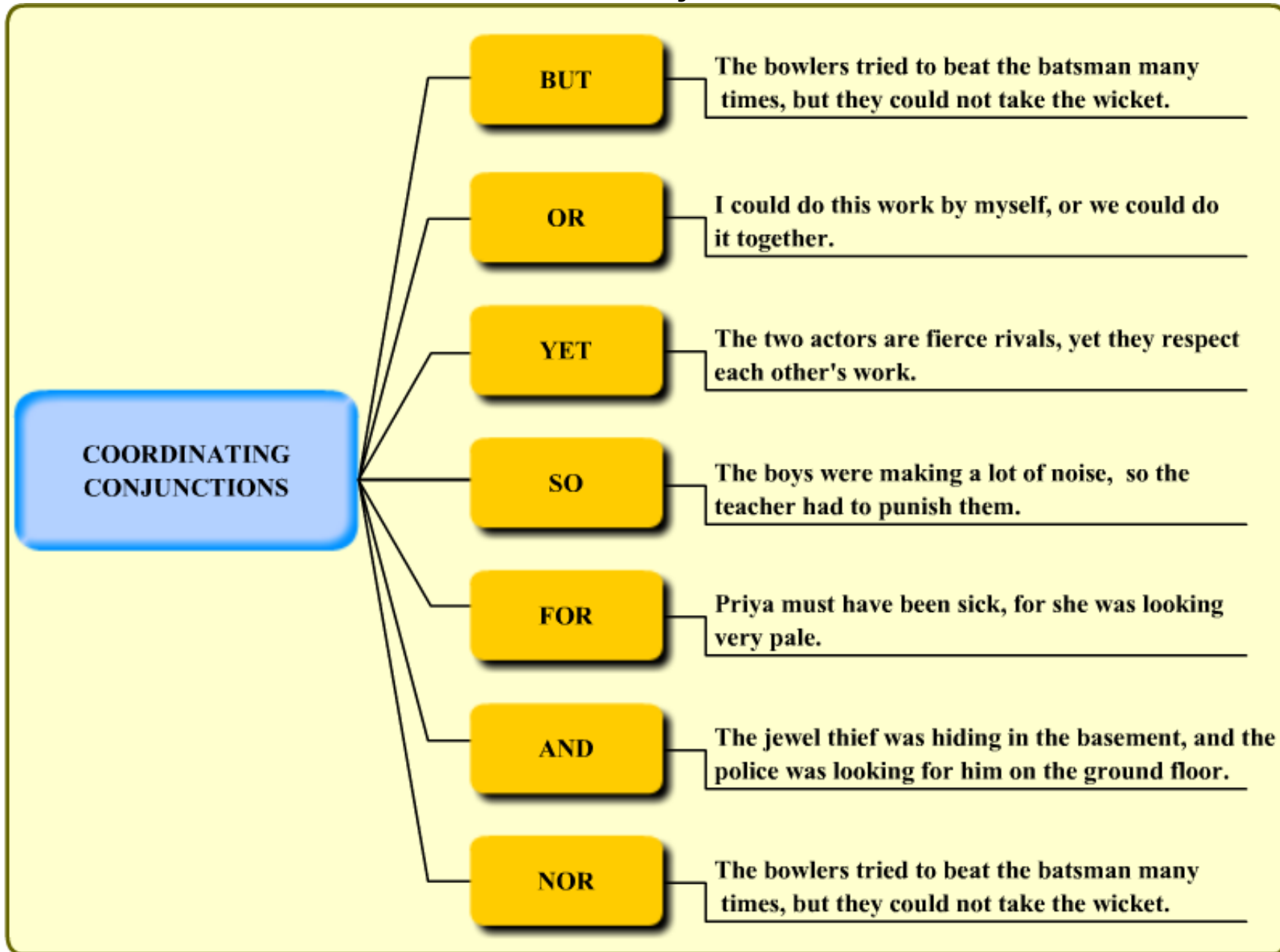


Conjunctions
